The Credit Portfolio Manager will be responsible for working with Credit Administration and the Market Bank on loan structure and terms, leading loan requests through the credit approval process, and assisting with the overall portfolio management.

The Credit Portfolio Manager will require direct client contact, providing financial analysis to maximize profitability, and will be a valuable member of the support team for the client. The candidate should have a thorough understanding of the terms and conditions under which the loans should be presented and closed.

Primary responsibilities are:

- Provide loan structure guidance and apply analysis assistance to mitigate risks in relationships consistent with Ameris Bank loan policies.
- Work with Regional Credit Officer in recommending appropriate structure, e.g., financial and non-financial covenants, and any special approval conditions.
